Retired since 2010 from work, but not from life, born in 1942, studied chemistry in Luxembourg and Strasbourg. PhD in 1970 on mechanisms studies of microbial degradation of diterpenes at Louis Pasteur University in Strasbourg. Certification as forensic toxicologist (1986) by GTFCh in Heidelberg.

Former head of toxicology department and research project manager at Laboratoire National de Santé (LNS) in Luxembourg, professor of organic & biochemistry at Luxembourg University, and forensic expert at Courts.

President of TIAFT (1996-2002), active fellow in many other toxicological associations and consultant to several international health organizations or institutions.

Author of more than 250 publications in periodicals or books and oral presenter of more than 400 topics at international congresses or universities.

Coordinator of continuing education in toxicology for many years on behalf of GTFCh.
